- 33% RAISE. In case you missed it, on November 4, 2014, the Contra Costa County Board
 of Supervisors passed an ordinance to increase their salaries by 33%, effective January 3,
 2015. They justified the pay increase by saying they are "underpaid" compared to other Bay
 Area Counties.
- IT'S NOT JUST ONE RAISE. The Ordinance forever ties the Supervisors' future salary increases to that of sitting Superior Court judges outside of public view and scrutiny. No more votes before the public. No transparency. Just automatic raises for the Supervisors.
